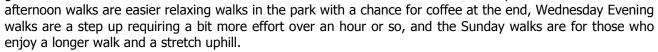

Looking for something to do on a Thursday? Want to meet some of the people that live in

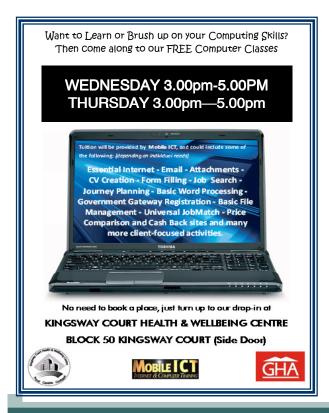
your community? Aged 50+?
